HSW05 SAFE WORK ENVIRONMENT

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient provision of a safe work environment.

Safe Work Environment is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression. The unit also provides a number of useful tools for use in your area of responsibility.

This unit only aims to address safe work environment provision aspects of the learner's responsibilities. Related aspects are covered in other units.

HSW06 SAFE TOOLS & EQUIPMENT

This unit is directed towards developing your understanding of the requirements for effective and efficient provision of safe tools and equipment.

Safe Tools and Equipment is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression. The unit also provides a number of useful tools for use in your area of responsibility.

This unit aims to address aspects of the learner's responsibilities in the provision of safe tools and equipment.

HSW07 SAFE WORKING

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient safe working. *Safe Working* is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression. The unit also provides a number of useful tools for use in your workplace.

HSW08 PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT USAGE

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effectively using protective equipment.

Protective Equipment Usage is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression.

Personal protective equipment (PPE) is the least desirable means of protecting people from hazards in the workplace for a number of reasons e.g. PPE may not be comfortable to wear. It is a challenge to encourage appropriate use of PPE at all times. PPE is, however, often the most practicable method of protection available for many tasks in a variety of workplaces.

HSW09 HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE USAGE

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient safe use of hazardous substances.

Hazardous Substances Usage is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression.

HSW10 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES ADMINISTRATION

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient administration of emergency procedures.

Emergency Procedures administration is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression.

This unit only aims to cover emergency procedure administration aspects of the learner's responsibilities. Related aspects are covered in other units.

HSW11 HAZARD CONTROL

This module is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient prevention of accidents. The key to accident prevention is the elimination or control of those hazards in the workplace that can lead to injury or damage accidents. Hazard control is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression. The module also provides a number of useful tools for use in your area of responsibility.

HSW12 FIRST AID PROVISION

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient provision for First Aid.

First Aid Provision is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression.

This unit aims to address First Aid provision aspects of the learner's responsibilities. Related aspects are covered in other units.

HSW14 ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION

This unit will provide you with the skills to investigate accidents in accordance with company standards. The efficient investigation of accidents relies strongly on the development of an understanding of the accident phenomenon and the use of a guided accident investigation model. Competencies in each of these areas will be developed as you work through the unit.

This unit is directed towards developing your knowledge of the requirements for effective and efficient investigation of accidents.

Accident Investigation is broken up into distinct and easily recognisable phases, and you will move through these phases step by step in a logical progression.

HSW15 SAFETY OBSERVATION

This unit is directed towards developing learner understanding of the safety observation process.

A Statement of Completion requires either:

- (a) The completion of units to the equivalent of more than 200 nominal hours followed by successful demonstration of competency in a minimum of nine units; or
- (b) Successful demonstration of competency in a minimum of nine units; or

(c) A combination of (a) and (b).
